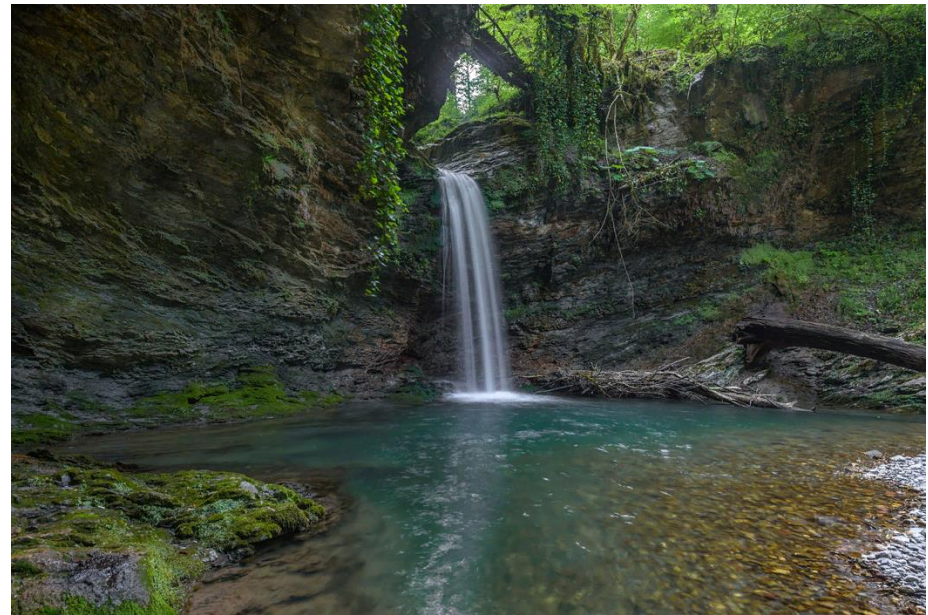

Sochi National Park

Sochi National Park was established on May 5, 1983 in order to preserve the unique natural complexes of the Black Sea coast of the Caucasus.

The National Park is located on the territory of Greater Sochi. Most of the park's territory is occupied by mountains separated by river valleys. About 40 rivers and streams of the Black Sea basin flow through the park.

The legend says that this paradise will exist as long as there is at least one bear in the forests. The aim of the park is to protect them. Brown bears are held in high esteem and under special protection here, almost like "sacred" animals. Scientists constantly monitor their population, so tourists are not allowed to enter the places in the national park where they live.



Greenland is the largest national park in the world. It is located in the north-east of Greenland. Its area is about 70 million hectares. This park, the only one in Greenland, is also the northernmost of all national parks in the world. The park is a home to 40% of the world population of musk oxen. Protected animals also include polar bears, walrus, arctic foxes, ermine, lemming, arctic hare, various species of seals, seals, narwhals, whales. Wolves often visit the park.





Greenland National Park

The Greenland National Park is the only national park in Greenland. It is also the northernmost and largest national park in the world. It has an area of 972 000 km² — larger than the area of 163 countries (separately). It covers an area in the north of East Greenland, east of North Greenland, and part of the territory of West Greenland. The purpose of the creation: to preserve the Arctic landscape and the unique ecosystem of Greenland — the largest island on Earth.

Death Valley

Death Valley is one of the most beautiful places in California, as well as a national reserve in the United States. This place is considered the hottest on earth. In July 1913 there was a temperature of 57°C in the shade. Death Valley is guarded to protect the gold mineral. The area of the park is 13 518 km^2 .
